Firefighters Sturgeon Derby Rules 2008

1. **Entry Fee \$30.00 Per Person**
2. **This Derby** is open to all participants that hold a valid Washington State Fishing License.
3. **Check-In** will be Saturday, June 21st from 8:00 a.m. to 11:00 a.m. at the Marysville Boat Launch, Langus Boat Launch, Port of Everett Boat Launch and at 2 Priest Point Dr. NE on the beach, pull your boat up, just look for the fire one the beach. All fees and registrations will be collected at Check-In and you will receive a ticket as proof of entry. Look for the firefighters at the launch sites.
4. **Derby Date: June 21st**
5. **Derby Time: 9:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m.**
6. **Derby Weigh-In Time: 10:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m.** No Sturgeon will be weighed in after 5:00 p.m.
7. **All Participants** must abide and follow all Washington Department of Fish and Wildlife Rules and Regulations at all times and supersede any rules or statements made or implied Lake Stevens Firefighters Local 3235 and Marysville Firefighters Local 3219. Please read WDFW regulations.
8. **All Participants** practice safe boat conduct and follow all Coast Guard rules and regulations.
9. **All Participants** are expected to follow high standards of sportsmanship, courtesy, safety and conservation. Any of these fundamental sporting principals may be deemed cause for automatic disqualification if not followed.
10. **The Limit:** Daily limit 1. White Sturgeon Min. size 42". Max. size 60". All fish that are of legal length shall be weighed in.
 - a. **NOTE: GREEN STURGEON may not be retained.**
11. **Area of Derby:** Snohomish River System **below US 2**, Snohomish River, Ebey, Union and Steamboat Slough out to Priest Point .
12. **Prizes** will be awarded in order: First Place heaviest fish, Second Place second heaviest fish, Third Place third heaviest fish.
13. **A Tie** in the derby will be resolved by weight and greatest length.

Thank you **Salmon University** for the use of their Sand Shrimp rigging information.

This is the same rigging system for Sturgeon. At the bottom of the form will be a diagram for setting up your fishing system.

Rigging Whole Sand Shrimp

Here's how to rig one of these fish catching crustaceans:

Remove any oversized claw from male sand shrimp. (Photo 2)



Fold the tail over and begin bringing the hook point through the center of one of the tail segments. (Photo 3)



Continue through the shrimp tail, exiting again through the center of a tail segment. (Photo 4)



Draw the hook all the way through the tail. (Photo 5)

Lodge the hook in the head, catching a portion of the tail first, then bringing the hook point out through the top of the head. Pull some line from the egg loop and place the loop over the shrimp. (Photo 6)



A good Salmon/Steelhead rod and reel combo works well for Sturgeon fishing. A huge Sturgeon may give you fits. You need a strong rod that casts well. Almost any heavy saltwater reel and rod combo will work. You can even use a large spinning reel.
